Now for the most important piece of news. Our Roma centre in Geoagiu is now officially accredited and open. At the moment we have 10 children registered and in November more will join us. PRAISE THE LORD. It has taken two years to get this far with lots of ups and downs with builders, paperwork, regulations and general exhaustion along the way.

Each time we thought we had run out of money, courage and energy the Lord provided. We had many words of encouragement from Him telling us not to be afraid but to keep going. Now finally all is done. We are still waiting on God's timing and provision for the completion of the upper floor but we are confident this will be done at the right time. At the moment we are just so thankful to be able to welcome children and their families into the centre and we praise God for being there with us through all the challenges. We have a fantastic new team. Tijs and Jessica of course and our teachers Ovidiu and Simona, our cleaner and overall

support and help Cristina and lastly our social worker Anuta.
