But we also lost three of our biggest regular donors virtually simultaneously and we have not yet seen people stepping forward to fill the gap. We have still been able to fund basic operations thanks to the dramatic fall of the Naira against hard currencies but recent signs are that high inflation is starting to outstrip currency depreciation. We have had to compensate for inflation in raising our staff salaries for 2025 and capacity to absorb that will be quite a test for us. Our desire to grow income to grow ministry remains just a dream for now. M & I, Nigeria
